

SHAVER LAKE CAMPGROUND 2010

Saturday April 3rd

It is time to set up our Shaver Lake campground for another season. Work day is scheduled for Saturday April 3rd (weather permitting-call me to verify). Volunteers are needed for general clean up, and setting up our wire pens. The FUN will start about 10am so bring your favorite tools- (gloves, rakes, loppers, shovels, pliers, hammers, wheel barrels) **and your favorite equine**. As soon as the work is complete, everybody is welcome to take a ride, so bring a sack lunch and let's take off exploring the trails.

Volunteers can camp Saturday night free, and could also take in a Sunday ride. No food will be provided Saturday or Sunday, however the restaurants are only about 1 mile away. Remember the camp elevation is about 5200'; and still could be cool during the day or night.

Directions: Hwy 168 to Shaver Lake. Turn right on the Dinkey Creek Road. Our camp is about one mile on the left hand side of the road. Watch for a BCHC sign at the camp entrance.
